Vinification : partial destemming,
9-day vatting, aging in tank and
vats for 8 months

**DOMAINE DE COLETTE
MORGON, « LES CHARMES »,
2020**

Schist and glacial moraine
Vinification : 15-day vatting, aging
in concrete vats for 10 months

**DOMAINE DE LA PIROLETTE
SAINT AMOUR, « LA POULETTE »,
2018**

Pink granite soil with deep clay
Vinification : gentle extraction,
aging in concrete eggs
