Altitude terroirs of Beaujolais

The hillside rows of vines grow at an average altitude of 300 metres, with peaks culminating at over 600 metres and plots on extreme slopes (over 30%). This type of wine growing is called 'heroic'. A cultural, ecological and geographical challenge.

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Mozaic soils : volcanic terroirs of blue stones

The blue stones come from ancient underwater volcanism. This hard rock, full of cracks, allows the roots of the vines to go down deep into the heart of the geological terroir. It endows the wines with a powerful, mineral and spicy character.

Partial egraping,

DOMAINE BERTRAND Juliéna - Les Fouillouses 2020

Medium deep soils on
weathered "blue stones",
average age of the vines:
60 years old

VINIFICATION :
Without sulphites - whole
bunches, maceration of 15
days – soft pressing on
pneumatic press, aging in
concrete tank for 15 months.

DOMAINE DES FOURNELLES Côte de Brouilly Cuvée Elixir - 2018

Porphyry shale soil,
average age of the vines:
90 years old

VINIFICATION :
Semi-Carbonic maceration,
aging in Oak.

Soil on weathered granite at
low depth,
clay-lomono-sandy,
average age of the vines:
20 years old

VINIFICATION :
No malolactic
fermentation, aging in
tank for 6 months.

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Mozaic soils : granitic terroirs

Granite is a mixture of different minerals which results from an alteration phenomenon, often very old. This disparate decomposition generates a very rich and complex terroir, offering powerful and colorful wines.

DOMAINE PHILIPPE VIET Régnié Cuvée Mosaïque - 2019

Degraded granites soils,
sands and silts,
average age of the vines:
65 years old

VINIFICATION :
semi-carbonic maceration,
aging in stainless steel vats
and sandstone jars for 10
months.

In organic conversion

DOMAINE DU GRANIT Chénas Cuvée Prestige - 2020

Sand-granitic soil,
average age of the vine:
60 years old

VINIFICATION :
indigenous yeasts, 50%
destemming - cold
maceration, aging in barrels
for 12 months

CHÂTEAU DES BACHELARDS Saint-Amour - 2020

Black granite soil – feldspar
loess and siliceous silt

VINIFICATION :
burgundy, indigenous yeasts
– aging in oak for 2 years.

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DOMAINE DE LA PAILLARDIÈRE Beaujolais Villages Cuvée 12M - 2020

Clay-limestone soil, average
age of the vines:
29 years old

VINIFICATION :
Start of fermentation in tank
and put in barrels at
mid-fermentation, aging for
12 months.

In organic conversion since
2019

If Beaujolais wines are mostly known for their youth, fruitiness and spontaneity, many of them become more refined over time, with more concentration, structure and maturation. True gastronomic wines !

VINIFICATION :
semi-carbonic,

Soils of weathered
granite and decaying
blue stones

VINIFICATION :
manual harvest, partial
egraping followed by a
15-day maceration, aging
on fine lees in stainless
steel tanks.

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DOMAINE NESME MICKAEL

2021

Sandy clay soil

VINIFICATION :
direct pressing and
vinification at low
temperature



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Collective process & premier cru goal

Among the appellations of Beaujolais, many plots are distinguished by their own identity. A process of recognition of some special places is underway, towards further mentions as "Premier cru".

Granite soil, average age
of the vines: 40 years old

VINIFICATION :
aging in concrete barrel
and tank.

DOMAINE DES NUGUES Fleurie Les Côtes - 2018

Pink granite soil,
average age of the vines:
70 years old

VINIFICATION :
semi-carbonic
fermentation, first racking
before malolactic
fermentation and vatting
for 18 days, aging in half
muid for 22 months.

DOMAINE RICHARD ROTTIER Moulin-à-Vent Les Thorins - 2019

Granite soil,
average age of the vine:
50 years old

VINIFICATION :
semi-carbonic maceration
in whole clusters, aging in
barrels for 8 months.

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DOMAINE LES CAPRÉOLES Beaujolais Lantignié Cuvée Axiome - 2021

Organic certification – Biodyvin,
glacial moraine soil, average age
of the vines: 6 years old

VINIFICATION :
long and oxidative pressing,
vinification in rooms without
inputs,
aging 9 months in pieces of 228
and 300L on full lees.
